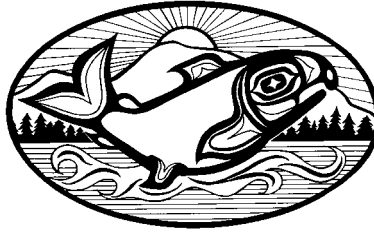


SALMON HOMECOMING CELEBRATION

YOU are invited to participate in the Salmon Homecoming Environmental Fair - Thursday, September 15 through 17, 2011 - taking place in Waterfront Park on the Seattle Downtown Waterfront, just south of the Seattle Aquarium. In the past, interactive presentations and displays have attracted the most interest and attention and are strongly encouraged.

We are expecting approximately 500 4th-5th grade students each day for the School Days program on Thursday, September 15th and Friday, September 16th. Please join us for this exciting event! **There is no fee for participation in the School Days event.** We will be coordinating with each education booth to participate in an interactive activity around one of the following themes:

- Salmon life cycle and ecosystems
- Habitat protection and restoration
- Stormwater and Pollution
- Culture and Communities

Exhibit spaces (10 ft. wide x 10 ft. deep) will be located in Waterfront Park. **A limited number of canopies are available – if you have your own, please bring it!** Set up must be accomplished by 9:30 a.m. Thursday, September 15th to accommodate the school day program. Tables must be staffed at all times during the hours of 10am–1pm. The Salmon Homecoming Celebration assumes no responsibility for your display.

Tables and chairs will be available to borrow from the event stock. Please indicate on your application if you will be requesting use of this equipment. Please be sure to provide your own hand truck, carts, etc. for loading and unloading.
